ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS - ROTHSCHILD STREET

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to facilitate carriageway repairs on Knights Hill and Thornlaw Road, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth after consulting London Buses intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily suspend parking on both sides of the entire length of Rothschild Street to enable buses on diversion and other traffic to navigate the diversion route on Rothschild Street.
- 2. Alternative routes for northbound affected vehicles on Knights Hill would be available via (a) Knights Hill, Rothschild Street, Norwood High Street, Ernest Avenue and Knights Hill. (b) Southbound traffic on Knights Hill is unaffected by the planned works.
- 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 10 September 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would take place between 10 September 2023 and 11 September 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 3 months.
