ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – ABBEVILLE ROAD

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable telecommunication works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Abbeville Road between Nos. 55 and 61 Abbeville Road.
- Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via:- (a) Narbonne Avenue, Klea Avenue, Hambalt Road and vice versa; (b) Narbonne Avenue, Elms Crescent, Hambalt Road and vice versa.
- 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs. Access for residents would be maintained.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 2 October 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works would take place between 2 October 2023 and 4 October 2023, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order would also have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 2 months.
