



# LAMBETH BOROUGH COUNCIL TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

LBC 2016 No. 29

## The Lambeth (Prescribed Routes) (No. 3) Traffic Order 2016

Made 24<sup>th</sup> May 2016

Coming into force 6<sup>th</sup> June 2016

---

The Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis and with the agreement of Transport for London in so far as they are the traffic authority for part of Electric Avenue, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into force on 6<sup>th</sup> June 2016 and may be cited as the Lambeth (Prescribed Routes) (No. 3) Traffic Order 2016.

2. (1) In this Order:

“cause” includes “permit”;

“Council” means the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth or their representative;

“enactment” means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment;

“goods” means goods of any kind whether animate or inanimate and includes postal packets of any description and “delivering” and “collecting” in relation to any goods, includes checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;

“goods vehicle” and “maximum gross weight” have the same meanings as in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016(b).

“valid hard-copy permit” means a permit which is produced on card, paper or similar and has not expired;

“particulars”, in relation to a valid hard-copy permit, mean:

- (a) the letters “MAR”;
- (b) the registration number of the vehicle for which the permit has been issued;
- (c) the date on which the permit expires; and
- (d) an indication that the permit has been issued by the Council;

“pedestrian zone” means any road or length of road specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 1 or 2 to this Order;

“permit” means a permit for a vehicle to enter the pedestrian zone specified in item 2 of Schedule 1 between 8 a.m. and 9 a.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive for the purposes of gaining access to a market stall or pitch within that pedestrian zone, and which will be issued or granted by the Council only in respect of a vehicle being used by the holder of a market stall or pitch in that pedestrian zone;

“postal packets” has the same meaning as in section 27 of the Postal Services Act 2011(a);

“relevant position”, in relation to the display of a valid hard-copy permit, means:

- (a) on the inside of the windscreen of the vehicle;
- (b) on the dashboard of the vehicle; or
- (c) where the vehicle does not have a windscreen or dashboard, in a conspicuous position on the front of the vehicle,

so that all the particulars on that permit are clearly displayed and visible from outside the vehicle and from the front of the vehicle;

“special event” means any street market, social or community event or entertainment about to be held, being held or having been held in a pedestrian zone;

“traffic signs” has the same meaning as in section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

“virtual permit” means a permit granted by the Council in respect of a vehicle the registration mark and other details of which are kept on a current list which is used by the Council for the purpose of identifying vehicles that are exempt from the provisions of Article 8 by virtue of proviso (b) of that Article.

(2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

(3) Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule shall, unless the context otherwise requires, be construed as a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

(4) Any reference in this Order to a numbered diagram shall be construed as a reference to the diagram so numbered in a Schedule to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016(b), and any reference in this Order to a numbered diagram that is revoked and re-enacted by a subsequent enactment shall be construed as a reference to the corresponding diagram number re-enacted by that subsequent enactment.

3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, the Lambeth (Prescribed Routes) (No. 2) Traffic Order 2015(c) is hereby revoked.

4. No person shall cause any vehicle, other than a pedal cycle, to proceed in any length of Electric Lane which lies:-

- (a) between a point 8 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Electric Avenue and that kerb-line; or
- (b) between the southern kerb-line of Electric Avenue and the northern kerb-line of Coldharbour Lane,

in a direction other than from north to south.

5. No person shall cause any vehicle proceeding in Coldharbour Lane, other than a pedal cycle, to enter that length of Electric Lane which lies north of the northern kerb-line of Coldharbour Lane.

6. No person shall cause any vehicle proceeding in Electric Avenue or that length of Electric Lane which lies south of the northern kerb-line of Electric Avenue, other than a pedal cycle, to enter that length of Electric Lane which lies north of the northern kerb-line of Electric Avenue.

7. No person shall cause any vehicle proceeding in that length of Electric Avenue which lies west of the western kerb-line of Electric Lane to turn left into Electric Lane.

8. No person shall cause any vehicle to enter any pedestrian zone specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 1 during the operational hours specified in column 3 of that item:

Provided that nothing in this Article shall apply in relation to a vehicle entering the pedestrian zone specified in column 2 of item 2 between 8 a.m. and 9 a.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive if that vehicle:-

- (a) has been granted a virtual permit; or
- (b) displays in the relevant position a valid hard-copy permit.

9. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to enter any pedestrian zone specified in column 2 of an item in Schedule 2 during the operational hours specified in column 3 of that item:

Provided that nothing in this Article shall apply in relation to any goods vehicle entering the pedestrian zone specified in column 2 of item 1 between 8 a.m. and 9 a.m. or between 5 p.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays or between 8 a.m. and 9 a.m. on Wednesdays for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading the vehicle, where and when this is not prohibited by any other enactment.

10. No person shall cause any goods vehicle the maximum gross weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes to enter Electric Avenue at any time.

11. No person shall cause any vehicle to enter any pedestrian zone specified in an item in Schedule 1 or 2 at such times and to such extent as shall be, for the time being, indicated by the placing of traffic signs to diagram 617 or temporary traffic signs showing the words "ROAD CLOSED":

Provided that nothing in this Article shall apply during the operational hours specified in column 3 of that item.

12. Nothing in Article 11 shall apply in relation to:-

- (a) any vehicle taking part in a special event or being used in connection with the setting up or closing down of a special event; or
- (b) any vehicle being used with the written consent of the Council provided that any conditions or requirements that they may impose are being complied with.

13. Nothing in Article 8, 9 or 10 shall apply in relation to:-

- (a) any vehicle being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of its statutory powers or other duties, provided that in all the circumstances it is reasonably necessary in the exercise of such powers or in the performance of such duties for that vehicle to enter a pedestrian zone;

- (b) any vehicle being used in connection with the maintenance, improvement, reconstruction, cleansing or lighting of a pedestrian zone, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer thereunder or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any electronic communications network (within the meaning of the Communications Act 2003(c)) thereunder or thereon;
- (c) any vehicle being used by or on behalf of the Council or the Metropolitan Police in connection with the removal of any vehicle deemed to have contravened or not complied with any restrictions or prescriptions, imposed by any enactment, regulation or order, on parking or waiting by vehicles in a pedestrian zone;
- (d) any vehicle being used to remove an obstruction from a pedestrian zone; or
- (e) any vehicle being used with the written consent of the Council provided that any conditions or requirements that they may impose are being complied with.

14. Nothing in Article 8, 9, 10 or 11 shall apply in relation to any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes if the observance of that Article would be likely to hinder the use of that vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion.

15. Nothing in Article 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 or 11 shall apply to:-

- (a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden; or
- (b) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to section 66 or 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

1.	Brixton Station Road between the eastern kerb-line of Brixton Road and the western kerb-line of Pope's Road.	Between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Sundays inclusive.
2.	Electric Avenue	Between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive.
3.	Pope's Road between the southern kerb-line of Brixton Station Road and the north-eastern kerb-line of Atlantic Road.	Between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Sundays inclusive.

1 Item No.	2 Pedestrian Zone	3 Operational Hours
1.	Electric Lane between the south-western kerb-line of Atlantic Road and the northern kerb-line of Coldharbour Lane.	Between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays and between 8 a.m. and 2 p.m. on Wednesdays.
