ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS – KEMPSHOTT ROAD AND COLMER ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable telecommunication installation and maintenance works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order, the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from:

- a) entering that length of Kempshott Road which lies between its junction with Tankerville Road and its junction with Ellison Road. (Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Ellison Road, Greyhound Lane and Tankerville Road or via Tankerville Road, Guildersfield Road and Ellison Road)
- b) entering, or parking, waiting, loading and unloading in that length of Colmer Road which lies between its junction with Danbrooke Road and No 26 Colmer Road. (Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Danbrook Road and Ellison Road and Vice Versa)
- c) parking, waiting, loading and unloading in that length of Kempshott Road which lies between 76 Kempshott Road and 86 Kempshott Road.

2. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

3. The Order would come into force on 18 September 2023 and continue in force for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner.
