The London Borough of Lambeth (Stopping-Up of Highways) (Headlam Road) Order 2023

Made 30th August 2023

The Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 247 of the

Town and Country Planning Act 1990(a), and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the London Borough of Lambeth (Stopping-Up of Highways) (Headlam Road) Order 2023 and shall come into force on the date on which notice that the Order has been made is first published in accordance with section 252(10) of the Act.
 - In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires:-

"Council" means the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth;


"deposited plan" means the drawing numbered CPC1-CTP-ZZ-ZZ-DR-C-1700-P03 and Drawing title: Highways Stopping Up Headlam Road, which is deposited at the offices of the Lambeth Council's Parking and Enforcement Group (Resident's Services), 3rd Floor, Civic Centre, 6 Brixton Hill, London SW2 1EG;

"planning application" and "planning permission" means planning application 17/03733/FUL.and the planning permission granted by the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government under Part III of the Act, on 20th December 2019; and

"statutory undertaker" has the same meaning as in section 262 of the Act.

3. The Council authorises the stopping-up of the areas of highway in the London Borough of Lambeth shown hatched on the deposited plan and described in the Schedule to this Order, in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission.

SCHEDULE

Descriptions of highway to be stopped-up

All that area of the highway of Headlam Road in the London Borough of Lambeth which is within the area shown hatched on the deposited plan and which lies between the south-eastern kerb-line of Clarence Avenue and a point 33 metres south-east of that kerb-line.
