PROPOSED BAN OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON STOCKWELL TERRACE WITH EXEMPTIONS FOR ACCESS.

PEDAL CYCLES, EMERGENCY VEHICLES AND VEHICLES WITH A VALID DISPENSATION VIA THE USE OF CCTV ENFORCEMENT

[NOTE: This Notice is about banning motor vehicles except for access on Stockwell Terrace. Objections or comments may be made – see paragraph 6.

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth proposes to make the Lambeth Prescribed Routes (Amendment No. -) Order 202- under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).
- 2. The general effect of the Order would be to ban motor vehicles with exemptions for access, pedal cycles, emergency vehicles, and vehicles with a valid dispensation via the use of CCTV enforcement in Stockwell Terrace from proceeding westward from the western kerb-line of Clapham Road (A3).
- 3. The proposals are intended to restrict through motor traffic on Stockwell Terrace while still retaining access to the adjacent properties and improve the amenity of residents.
