ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS – STREATHAM WELLS LTN

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to facilitate the installation of a low traffic neighbourhood scheme, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from waiting, loading, or parking on certain lengths of the highway at: -

- a) Culverhouse Gardens, both sides, from the junction of Leigham Court Road south for 50 metres;
- b) Gleneldon Road, the south side, between No. 68 Gleneldon Road and a point opposite the common boundary of Nos. 121 and 123 Gleneldon Road
- c) Strathdale, both sides, from the junction of Valleyfield Road southwards for 18 metres;
- d) Valley Road, both sides, from the junction of Gleneldon Road northward for 50 metres;
- e) Valley Road, both sides, from the junction of Leigham Court Road southward for 65 metres;
- f) Valleyfield Road, both sides, between Nos. 43 and 59 Valleyfield Road.

2. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

3. The Order would come into force on 9 October 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would take place between 9 October 2023 and 20 October 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 1 month.
