



LAMBETH BOROUGH COUNCIL TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

LBC 2023 No. 60

The Lambeth (Prescribed Routes) (No. 7) Traffic Order 2023

Made 6th September 2023

Coming into force 2nd October 2023

The Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into force on 2nd October 2023 and may be cited as the Lambeth (Prescribed Routes) (No. 7) Order 2023.

2. (1) In this Order:

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment;

"cause includes "permit" and "causing" includes "permitting";

"pedal cycle" has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016(b);

(2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

3. No person causing any vehicle, other than a pedal cycle, to proceed in Rosendale Road shall thereupon cause that vehicle to turn left into Turney Road.

4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply in relation to any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes if the observance of that Article would be likely to hinder the use of that vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion.

5. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply to:-

- (a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden; or
- (b) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to section 66 or 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
