LBC 2023 No. 67

The Lambeth (Prescribed Routes) (Amendment No. 9) Order 2023

Made 29 September 2023

Coming into force 29 September 2023

The Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into force on 29 September 2023 and may be cited as the Lambeth (Prescribed Routes) (Amendment No. 9) Order 2023.

2. (1) In this Order:

“**1984 Act**” means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

“**2003 Act**” means the Communications Act 2003;

“**the 2011 Act**” means the Postal Services Act 2011;

“**2016 Regulations**” means the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;

“**Council**” means the London Borough of Lambeth;

“**enactment**” means any enactment, whether public general or local and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme, or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment;

“**cause**” includes “**permit**” and “**causing**” includes “**permitting**”.

“**goods**” means goods of any kind whether animate or inanimate and includes postal packets of any description, and “**delivering**” and “**collecting**” in relation to any goods includes checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;

“**pedal cycle**” has the same meaning as in the 2016 Regulations;

“**restricted road**” means Stockwell Terrace;

“**valid dispensation**” means a dispensation granted by the Council to a resident of the restricted road to exempt the holder from the prohibition in Schedule 1 to this Order subject to meeting the Council's terms and conditions of use;

(2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by, or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

(3) Any reference in this Order to a numbered Schedule shall, unless the context otherwise requires, be construed as a reference to the Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

3. No person shall cause any vehicle proceeding in any road or length of road specified in column (2) of Schedule 1 of this Order to proceed in a direction specified in column (3) of that item unless the vehicle has an exemption specified in column (4) of that item.

4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply in relation to:-

- (1) any vehicle with a valid dispensation;
- (2) any vehicle being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of its statutory powers or other duties, provided that in all the circumstances it is reasonably necessary in the exercise of such powers or in the performance of such duties for that vehicle to enter the restricted road;
- (3) any vehicle being used in connection with the maintenance, improvement, reconstruction, cleansing or lighting of the restricted road, or the laying, erection, alteration, or repair of any sewer thereunder or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, or electricity or of any electronic communications network within the meaning of the 2003 Act; at or in the restricted road;
- (4) any vehicle being used by or on behalf of the Council or the Police in connection with the removal of any vehicle deemed to have contravened or not complied with any restrictions or prescriptions, imposed by any enactment, regulation, or Order, on parking or waiting by vehicles in the restricted road;
- (5) any vehicle being used to remove an obstruction from the restricted road; or
- (6) anything done with the written permission of the Council or its representative, provided that any conditions or requirements they may impose are being complied with or at the direction of a police constable in uniform;
- (7) any vehicle displaying a valid disabled badge provided the vehicle is being used to access and park in the disabled bay or permit holder parking bay on the restricted road;
- (8) the vehicle is being used:- waiting only for as long as is necessary:-
 - (a) by a universal postal service to properties on Stockwell Terrace provided the vehicle has the livery of a universal service provider;
 - (b) the vehicle is being used for the delivery or collecting goods or burden to properties on Stockwell Terrace;
 - (c) to enable a resident or person visiting Stockwell Terrace to board or alight from a vehicle.
