ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS - CROSSFORD STREET

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to facilitate a water main connection, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Crossford Street which lies between Eastcote Street and the south-west boundary wall of Sidgwick House.
- 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Eastcote Street, Irving Grove, Stockwell Road (A203), Stockwell Green, and Lingham Street and vice versa.
- 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 23 October 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would take place between 23 October 2023 and 25 October 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 2 months.
