ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS - LANSDOWNE HILL

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to facilitate British Telecom repairs, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Lansdowne Hill which lies between the junctions of Royal Circus and Waldeck Grove.
- 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via (a) Waldeck Grove, Canterbury Grove, and Royal Circus and vice versa.
- 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 19 October 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would take place for one day on 19 October 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 1 month.
