ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS - MEPHAM STREET & TENISON STREET

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to facilitate public realm improvements, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth after consulting Transport for London (TfL) intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Mepham Street which lies between York Road (A3200) and Tenison Way.
- 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available for buses via (a) York Road (A3200), Westminster Bridge Road (A302), Baylis Road (B300), and Waterloo Road; business loading only would be available (b) in a north-westerly direction via Waterloo Road, Mepham Street, Tenison Way, Waterloo Road and (c) in a south-easterly direction via Mepham Street and Waterloo Road.
- 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 23 October 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would take place between 23 October 2023 and 9 December 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 3 months.
