ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS – ST JULIAN’S FARM ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to facilitate Thames Water maintenance works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of St Julian’s Farm Road which lies between its junction with Knight’s Hill and the western property boundary of No. 88 Knight’s Hill.
2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via a) Knight’s Hill, Norwood Road, York Hill, Royal Circus, Pyrmont Grove, Canterbury Grove, Thurlestone Road, Dodbrooke Road, Hainthorpe Road, Wolfington Road and Casewick Road,
and (b) Casewick Road, Thornlaw Road and Knight’s Hill.
3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order will come into force on 16 October 2023 and continue in force for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would take place between 16 October 2023 and 29 October 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 3 months.
