ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS – CENTAUR STREET

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable a detailed bridge inspection to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, after consulting Transport for London (TfL), intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Centaur Street from the junction of Carlisle Lane eastward for 60 metres.
2. One-way working to be suspended to allow temporary two-way working to be introduced to maintain access on (a) Carlisle Lane between the junctions of Centaur Street and Hercules Road; (b) Royal Street between the junctions of Centaur Street and Upper Marsh.
3. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via (a) Carlisle Lane, Hercules Road, Lambeth Road, and Kennington Road; and (b) (A3036) Lambeth Palace Road, Lambeth Road, and Kennington Road.
4. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
5. The Order would come into force on 6 December 2023 and would continue for a 1-month maximum duration (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would take place between 6 December 2023 and 7 December 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 1 month.
