## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

## TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS – GIBBS AVENUE, HERMITAGE ROAD, OXFORD ROAD, AND ROMAN RISE

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to facilitate the installation of a new electrical service, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth after consulting Transport for London (TfL) and Croydon Council intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering:-
  - (a) Gibbs Avenue and Roman Rise which lies between the north-eastern kerb-line of the A214 Central Hill and a point 30 metres north-east of the said kerb-line;
  - (b) Oxford Road and Hermitage Road in the London Borough of Croydon between the southwestern kerb-line of Central Hill and a point 10 metres south of the said kerb-line.
  - (c) Traffic signals on Central Hill will control traffic during the Roman Rise and Oxford Road closure when the Hermitage Road bus stops on either side of Central Hill will be suspended.
- 2. The closures of Gibbs Avenue and Hermitage Road, and the closure of Roman Rise and Oxford Road will not happen at the same time. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available for the (a) Gibbs Avenue closure via Central Hill, Roman Rise, and Bloomhall Road and vice versa; (b) Hermitage Road via Central Hill, Rockmount Road, Chevening Road and Hermitage Road and vice versa; (c) Oxford Road closure via Central Hill, Hermitage Road, and Crystal Terrace and vice versa; (d) Roman Rise closure via Central Hill, Gibbs Avenue, and Bloomhall Road and vice versa.
- 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 18 November 2023 and would continue for a 6-month maximum duration (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works for the Gibbs Avenue and Hermitage Road closure would take place between 18 November 2023 and 20 November 2023; Oxford Road and Roman Rise closure would take place between 21 November 2023 and 26 November 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 6months.
