ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS - GLENEAGLE ROAD

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to facilitate sewer maintenance works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering the length of Gleneagle Road between the junctions of Ambleside Avenue and Fairmile Avenue.
- 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Ambleside Avenue, Babington Road, Conyers Road, Fairmile Avenue and vice versa.
- 3. Access to properties will be always maintained. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 13 November 2023 and would continue for a 2-month maximum duration (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would take place between 13 November 2023 and 15 November 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 2 months.
