TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS - GRESHAM ROAD

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to facilitate new service installations by SGN, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Gresham Road which lies between its junction with Brixton Station Road and its junction with Coldharbour Lane in a southbound direction. Northbound traffic would be unaffected.
- 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Brixton Station Road and Barrington Road. Buses would be diverted via Barrington Road.
- 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 13 November 2023 and would continue in force for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would take place between 13 November 2023 and 24 November 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 1 month.
