## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

## **TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS – SALAMANCA STREET**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable a detailed bridge inspection to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, after consulting Transport for London (TfL), intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles (including cyclists) and pedestrians from entering that length of Salamanca Street which lies between Salamanca Place and Randall Road.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via (a) Vauxhall Walk, Tinworth Street, (A3036) Albert Embankment, Black Prince Road and Albert Embankment Slip Road; and (b) Albert Embankment Slip Road, (A3036) Albert Embankment, Black Prince Road, and Vauxhall Walk.

3. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 5 December 2023 and would continue for a 1-month maximum duration (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would take place between 5 December 2023 and 6 December 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 1 month.
