## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

## TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE BRIARWOOD ROAD

- 1. NOTICE IS GIVEN that, to enable mains water maintenance works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order, the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Briarwood Road which lies between the common boundary of Nos. 10 and 12 Briarwood Road and the common boundaries of Nos 20 and 22 Briarwood Road. Access for residents will be maintained.
- 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via: Crescent Lane, Abbeville Road and vice versa.
- 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 11 December 2023 for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect between 11 December 2023 and 15 December 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time then the Order may have effect on subsequent days within the maximum duration of 2 months.
