

LAMBETH BOROUGH COUNCIL TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

LBC 2023 No. 87

The Lambeth (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. 28) Order 2023

Made 1 December 2023

Coming into force 4 December 2023

The Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Lambeth (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. 28) Order 2023 and shall come into force on 4 December 2023.

Interpretation

2. (1) In this Order:

"the Order of 2023" means The Lambeth (Charged-For Parking Places) Order 2023(b).

"map-based schedule" means the map attached to and to be read in conjunction with this Order, which depicts the parking places designated by this Order, and in conjunction with the map schedule legend, identifies the type of each particular parking place and, if appropriate, certain of its governing provisions:

Provided that the Council does not accept responsibility for any inaccuracies contained in the Ordnance Survey data relied upon to create the map-based schedule and where a parking place is depicted on the map-based schedule, that parking place will continue to apply irrespective of any subsequent changes that have been made to the underlying Ordnance Survey data.

"map schedule legend" means the map schedule legend presented with the map-based schedule which, when used in conjunction with the map-based schedule, the Articles of this Order, and the following table of disambiguations (where applicable):

identifies the specific type of parking places designated by this Order, and, where appropriate, certain of their governing provisions;

"parking place" means an area on a highway designated as a parking place by this Order, being either: a residents permit holders parking place, or a residents permit holders parking place reserved for electric vehicles, or a permit holders parking place, a permit holders parking place reserved for electric vehicles, or a shared-use permit holders and pay parking place, or a 'crossborough' residents permit holders and pay parking place, or a 'cross-borough' permit holders parking place, or a shared-use 'cross-borough' permit holders and pay parking place, or a pay parking place, or a business permit holders parking place, or a doctors parking place or, a car club parking place, and in each case being identified as such type in the map-based schedule by reference to the map schedule legend;

- (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- (3) Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2023 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

Amendments to the Order of 2023

3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, the Order of 2023 is hereby varied as identified in the map-based schedule.

Designation of parking places and application of the Order of 2023 thereto

- 4. (1) Each area on a highway identified in the map-based schedule as a parking place and by way of the map schedule legend as an area signed or marked out, or both, for the use therein of specified classes of vehicles following the conditions specified in this Order in relation to that parking place, is a designated parking place.
 - (2) Unless otherwise so identified, a parking place shall be either:-
 - (a) in the case of a parking place identified in the map-based schedule or by way of the map schedule legend, or both, as being a parking place indicated on-street by way of a 'permit parking area' sign in accordance with Item 5 of Schedule 5, Part 3 to the Traffic Signs

Regulations and General Directions 2016, comprising the length, and unless otherwise so specified, the full width of the carriageway of a street so identified in the map-based schedule; or

- (b) in the case of any other parking place, bounded on one side of its length by the edge of the carriageway and be an area marked out to a road marking and indicated by a regulatory sign, either in accordance with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 or, if applicable, by virtue of any special authorisation given by the Department for Transport.
- (3) The provisions of the Order of 2023 (other than Articles 4 and 17) shall apply to each area designated as a parking place by this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a parking place included a reference to each area designated as a parking place by this Order and as if any reference to the map-based schedule to the Order of 2023 included a reference to the map-based schedule.

Placing of traffic signs at parking places

- 5. The Council shall:
 - (1) place and maintain road markings indicating the limits of each parking place, other than a parking place of the type described in Article 4(2)(a);
 - (2) place and maintain in or in the vicinity of each parking place, traffic signs indicating that such parking place may be used during the permitted hours for the leaving only of the vehicles specified in Article 5;
 - (3) place and maintain in or in the vicinity of each parking place a traffic sign indicating, how it may be used; and,
 - (4) carry out such other work as is reasonably required for the purposes of the satisfactory operation of a parking place.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This is not part of the Order but used to help explain its purpose)

The Lambeth (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. 28) Order 2023

The general effect of the Order, in conjunction with the Lambeth (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. *) Order 2023, is to remove certain lengths of parking place and to relocate certain other lengths of parking places in Loughborough Road in conjunction with the installation of mandatory cycle lanes.

- (a) to remove all existing permit holder only and shared use parking places, along the kerb-lines on Loughborough Road, on both sides, between Lilford Road and Styles Gardens.
- (b) to introduce new parking places situated approximately 1.7 metres away from the kerb-line in Loughborough Road at the following locations:-

the north-east side,

- (1) from a point 2.4 metres north-west of the south-eastern wall of No. 113 Loughborough Road north-westward for 19.2 metres;
- (2) from a point 5 metres south-east of the south-eastern wall of No. 113 Loughborough Road southeastward for 32 metres;
- (3) from a point 7.5 metres south-east of the south-eastern wall of Nos. 21/42/63 Elmore House to a point 14 metres south-east of the north-westernmost wall of Nos. 1 to 53 Nevil House.

the south-west side,

- (1) from a point 34 metres south-east of Barrington Road south-eastward for 41 metres.
- (c) in Minet Road to reduce the length of the existing shared use parking places:-
 - (1) the north-west side, 5.5 metres north-east of Loughborough Road by 2 metres;
 - (2) the south-east side, 5 metres north-east of Loughborough Road by 5 metres.
