ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS – MARTELL ROAD

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water to carry out maintenance works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Martell Road which lies between the southern property boundary of No. 58 Martell Road and Martell Road's junction with Myton Road, and to suspend parking between Nos. 41 and 58 Martell Road.
- 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Myton Road, Rosendale Road, Tritton Road and vice-versa
- 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order will come into force on 5 February 2024 and continue in force for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would take place between 5 February 2024 and 9 February 2024, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 6 months.
