The Lambeth (Stopping-Up of Highways) (Elder Road) Order 2024

Made 12 January 2024

Coming into force 12 January 2024

---

The Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended), and of all other enabling powers make the following Order:-

### **Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the London Borough of Lambeth (Stopping-Up of Highways) (Elder Road) Order 2024 and shall come into force on 12 January 2024.

### **Interpretation**

2. In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires:-
  - “**the 1990 Act**” means the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended);
  - “**Council**” means the London Borough of Lambeth;
  - “**deposited plan**” means the drawing numbered 23027-001A, Project title: Park Tavern, Lambeth, and Drawing title: Stopping Up Plan, which is deposited at the offices of the Parking and Enforcement Group (Resident’s Services), 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Civic Centre, 6 Brixton Hill, London SW2 1EG;
  - “**planning application**” and “**planning permission**” means planning permission 22/00442/FUL granted in December 2022;
  - “**statutory undertaker**” has the same meaning as in section 262 of the 1990 Act.
3. The Council authorises the stopping-up of the areas of highway shown hatched on the deposited plan and described in the Schedule to this Order, to enable development to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission.

4. Any statutory undertaker having apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across the areas of highway authorised to be stopped-up by this Order, shall have the same rights as respects that apparatus after those areas of highway are stopped-up as they had immediately beforehand.

#### SCHEDULE

##### Description of highway to be stopped-up

All the area of highway of Elder Road in the London Borough of Lambeth which is shown hatched on the deposited plan and is bounded on the north-western edge of the highway, the building line of Nos.54 and 56 Elder Road, and extends from a point opposite the common boundary of Nos. 52 and 54 Elder Road and the common boundary of Nos. 56 and 58 Elder Road.
