**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – ST JULIAN’S FARM ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable SGN new connection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering in that length of St Julian’s Farm Road, between property no. 2 St Julian’s Farm Road and property no. 2d St Julian’s Farm Road for a length of approximately 20 metres.
2. An alternative route for affected vehicles would be available via (a) Casewick Road, Thornlaw Road, Knights Hill, (b) Knights Hill, Norwood Road, York Hill, Royal Circus, Pymont Grove, Canterbury Grove and Thurlestone Road.
3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing and covering of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order would come into force on 16 January 2024 and would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works would take place between 16 January 2024 and 18 January 2024, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order would also have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 2 months.
