ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - CAMBRIA ROAD

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Commex to carry out maintenance works safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Cambria Road which lies between its junction with Coldharbour Lane and a point 10 metres south-east of Coldharbour Lane.
- 2. Alternative routes for vehicles would be available (i) Coldharbour Lane, Harbour Road and Southwell Road; and (ii) Southwell Road, Padfield Road and Coldharbour Lane.
- 3. Whenever the ban referred to in paragraph 1 above applies, the one-way system in that length of Cambria Road which lies between Coldharbour Lane and Southwell Road would be temporarily suspended to allow access to and egress from properties and premises in that length of road.
- 4. The ban and suspension would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing and covering of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 5 The Order would come into force on19th February 2024 and would continue for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the said works have been completed, whichever is earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect on 19th February 2024 between the hours of 9.30 am and 3 pm, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed on that date, the Order may also have effect on subsequent days, within the maximum period of 3 months.
