## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

## TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS - LEIGHAM COURT ROAD

- 1. NOTICE IS GIVEN that to facilitate mains water works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth after consulting Transport for London (TfL) intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily suspend the bus stop and bus lane to maintain two-way traffic flow on Leigham Court Road from the junction of Streatham High Road to outside No. 39 Leigham Court Road.
- 2. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 3. The Order would come into force on 4 March 2024 and would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would take place between 4 March 2024 and 8 March 2024, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 2 months.
