ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS - PADFIELD ROAD

- 1. NOTICE IS GIVEN that, to facilitate a bridge examination, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intends to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles and pedestrians from entering Padfield Road and suspend parking between the junction of Southwell Road and a point 40 metres south of that junction.
- 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Coldharbour Lane and Herne Hill Road and vice versa. An alternative temporary footway will be provided as part of the works.
- 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 20 February 2024 and would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would take place overnight between 22:00 and 06:00 on 20/21 February 2024, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 1 month.
