## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

## TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS - THE PAVEMENT

- 1. NOTICE IS GIVEN that, to facilitate mains power repair and maintenance works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily suspend the cycle lane and adjacent footway on the south-west side of The Pavement between Old Town and Bromell's Road.
- 2. Pedestrians will be diverted at suitable crossing points to the opposite side of the road. Cyclists will be able to use the main carriageway.
- 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 4 March 2024 and would continue for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would take place between 4 March 2024 and 18 March 2024, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 3 months.
