ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS – LEIGHAM VALE

1. NOTICE IS GIVEN that to facilitate sewer replacement works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering and stopping, waiting, and loading on Leigham Vale between the junction of Knollys Road and the south-western boundary of No. 8 Leigham Vale.
2. The following banned turns into Leigham Vale will apply from:- (a) Knollys Road, (b) Stockfield Road (except for access), (c) Hitherfield Road (except for access), (d) Palace Road (except for access).
3. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Leigham Court Road, Glennie Road, Royal Circus, York Hill, Norwood Road and vice versa.
4. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
5. The Order would come into force on 29 March 2024 and would continue for a maximum duration of 6 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would take place between 29 March 2024 and 26 April 2024, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 6 months.
