- 4. Nomination papers must be accompanied by a deposit of £1,000. The deposit can be paid either online, by the deposit of any legal tender, or by means of a banker's draft from a drawer which carries on business as a banker in the United Kingdom.
- 5. If the election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday 2 May 2024.
- 6. Applications to register to vote for this election must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer* by **midnight on Tuesday 16 April 2024**.
- Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes for this election must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer* by 5pm on Wednesday 17 April 2024.
- 8. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer* by **5pm on Wednesday 24 April 2024**.
- Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Electors document valid for this election must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer* by 5pm on Wednesday 24 April 2024.
- 10. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity, work, or due to loss, theft, destruction or damage of required photo ID, must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer* by **5pm on Thursday 2 May 2024**. To apply to vote by emergency proxy, the applicant must have become aware of the reason that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 24 April 2024.
