THE ACHIEVEMENT OF POLISH PUPILS IN LAMBETH Executive Summary - 2023

1. Introduction

This report presents the results of the 2023 Key Stage 1, 2, and GCSE tests and assessments for Polish pupils in Lambeth. The purpose of this report is to encourage the use of Key Stage data and to provide questions as a basis for improving Key Stage performance for Polish pupils in schools.

2. Overall Achievement and Main Findings

Table 1, shows the performance of Polish pupils in all Key Stages in 2023. There are no national data for Polish pupils.

Polish pupils are above Lambeth and national figures in all key stages and subjects. At Key Stage 2, Polish pupils are higher than both Lambeth and the national average in all subjects and all subjects combined. Polish pupils are also above Lambeth and national figures for all the major indicators at GCSE.

3. Contextual Factors Influencing Key Stage Achievement

A pupil's social and economic background can affect educational achievement. The following sections discuss gender, ethnicity, free school meal entitlement, English as an Additional Language and Special Educational Needs as factors affecting Key Stage results. All calculations for the "gap" between different factors are subject to rounding. Some data is not available as national figures. It is worth considering the size of the pupil cohort when comparing figures.

Gender

In Lambeth girls had a higher percentage in all Key Stages. This difference was also reflected nationally. For Polish pupils, this remains the same for all key stages except for Maths at Key Stage 2.

Free School Meals

Children who were eligible for free school meals scored a lower percentage in all Key Stages, in both Lambeth and nationally. The gaps between eligible and non-eligible for Polish children are variable because there are less pupils with FSM. For example, there are only nine Polish pupils eligible for free school meals at GCSE, skewing figures.

Ethnic background

Table 5, shows that at Key Stage 1, Polish pupils are amongst the highest performing ethnicities in Lambeth. At KS1 Polish are highest performers with an average of 76%. At KS2, highest performers are also Polish with 84% achieving the expected standard in Reading Maths and Writing. Polish pupils are the highest performers at all indicators at GCSE.

Compared to national data, Lambeth Polish pupils are one of the highest achieving groups at Key Stage 1, and 2. At Key Stage 1, Lambeth Polish pupils perform highly compared to national figures, with an average of 76%. AT Key Stage 2, polish are also highest with 84% at RWM. At the GCSE indicators of English and Maths grades 9 to 4, Attainment 8 and Progress 8, Lambeth Polish pupils achieve higher than the main national ethnic groups.

Fluency in English

Generally in Lambeth, the higher a pupil's level of English the better they perform, with fully fluent pupils often outperforming pupils who are monolingual English speakers. There are differences for Polish pupils but much is due to cohort sizes, see table 7 below.

Special Educational Needs

As Special Educational Needs increase with a pupil, performance at all Key Stages decreases. The small number of pupils with an EHCP or Statement can skew figures.
