ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – COTTAGE GROVE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable works involving the operation of a crane, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Cottage Grove which lies between a point 44.5 metres east of Bedford Road and the party wall of Nos. 46 and 48 Cottage Grove.
2. The ban on vehicles entering the length of Cottage Grove referred to above would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
3. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via (i) Bedford Road, Clapham Road, Mayflower Road, Tregothnan Road, Prideaux Road, Landor Road and Willington Road; and (ii) Willington Road, Landor Road and Bedford Road.
4. The Order would come into force on 12th April 2024 and would continue in force for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingences) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works would be carried out on the 12th and 13th April 2024 and 16th and 17th April 2024 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed on those dates then the Order may have effect on subsequent days up to the maximum period of 2 months.
