ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS – VOSS COURT

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable gas main connection works to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering, parking or waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading a vehicle) in that length of Voss Court which lies between the common boundary of Nos. 2 and 3 Voss Court and the common boundary of Nos. 4 and 5 Voss Court.

2. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

3. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via (a) Streatham High Road, Westwell Road Approach, Westwell Road, Greyhound Lane, Streatham High Road and Streatham Common South; and (b) Streatham Common South and Streatham High Road.

4. The Order would come into force on 15th April 2024 and would continue in force for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingences) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works would be carried out between 15th and 26th April 2024 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed in that time then the Order may have effect on subsequent days up to the maximum period of 2 months.
