

Glenbrook amalgamate with Kings Avenue

Glenbrook Primary School is a community, two-form entry, co-educational primary school, located in the London Borough of Lambeth. The Published Admission Number (PAN) was 60 up to 2019/20 which was reduced to 30 in 2020/21 and the school agreed to further reduce the PAN to 15 for September 2024.

The school is part of the educational provision of the London Borough of Lambeth and is part of the Gipsy Hill Federation. The school is situated in Clarence Crescent, London SW4 8LD.

Kings Avenue School, is a community, three-form entry, co-educational primary school, located in the London Borough of Lambeth. The Published Admission Number (PAN) was 90 up to 2009/10 which was gradually reduced to 30 from 2020/21 and the school agreed to further reduce the PAN to 15 for September 2024.

The school is situated in Kings Avenue, London SW4 8BQ.

Both schools are in the West planning area. In January 2024, 109 Reception places (approximately equivalent to 4 classes or 20.8%) in primary schools in the West planning area were vacant.

In January 2024, Glenbrook had 135 pupils on roll in Reception to Year 6 out of a possible 300 total PAN. Based on the physical size of the school, in January 2024 Glenbrook was 68% empty, with 285 spaces for additional pupils.

In January 2024, Kings Avenue had 141 pupils on roll in Reception to Year 6 out of a possible 300 total PAN. Based on the physical size of the school, in January 2024 Kings Avenue was 66% empty, with 279 spaces for additional pupils.

Glenbrook is 750 metres from Kings Avenue, an 11-minute walk according to a Google Maps walking route.
