



LAMBETH BOROUGH COUNCIL TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

LBC 2023 No. 82

The Lambeth (Prescribed Routes) (No. 12) Experimental Traffic Order 2023

Made 3 November 2023

Coming into force 13 November 2023

The Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into force on 13 November 2023 and may be cited as the Lambeth (Prescribed Routes) (No. **) Experimental Traffic Order 2023.

2. In this Order:

“**the 1984 Act**” means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

“**the 2016 Regulations**” means the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 (as amended);

“**Council**” means the London Borough of Lambeth;

“**goods**” means goods of any kind and includes postal packets of any description and “**delivering**” and “**collecting**” in relation to any goods, includes checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;

“**pedal cycle**” has the same meaning as in the 2016 Regulations;

“**pedestrian and cycle zone**” means that length of a road specified in the Schedule to this Order;

“**permit holder**” means a person or a disabled persons (Blue) badge who either resides at or whose employment is at an address in column 4 of the Schedule to this Order and is granted a permit by the Council to enter the pedestrian and cycle zone;

Provided that where the main place of residence or employment of that person has ceased to be at those premises, then they shall no longer be a permit holder;

“**prescribed hours**” means the periods specified in the Schedule;

“**Schedule**” means the Schedule to this Order;

“**traffic sign**” in this Order means the type shown in Diagram 618.3C in the 2016 Regulations;

3. Subject to Article 4 of this Order, no person, other than a permit holder, shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter the pedestrian and cycle zone provided that traffic signs are in place at the entry

to the zone during the prescribed hours.

4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply:-

- (a) in relation to any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes if the observance of that Article would be likely to hinder the use of that vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion;
- (b) to anything done with the written permission of the Council
- (c) to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
- (d) to any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to section 66 or 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

5. In pursuance of section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Assistant Director of Infrastructure, Environment, Public Realm & Climate Change Delivery or some other person authorised in that behalf by them, may, if it appears to him or that other person essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic, or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by this Order runs, modify or suspend the operation of this Order or any provision of it, save that no modification shall make an addition.
