## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

## TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE VIRGIL STREET

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable sewer connection works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order, the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles (including cyclists) from entering Virgil Street (the whole length).
- 2. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 3. An alternative route for affected motor vehicles would be available via Hercules Road, Cosser Street, Kennington Road, Lambeth Road, Hercules Road and Carlisle Lane.
- 4. Cyclists to dismount and use the footway.
- 5. The Order would come into force on 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2024 for a maximum duration of 1 month or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that works would be carried out between 22<sup>nd</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> July 2024, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during those dates, the Order may also have effect on subsequent dates within the maximum period of 1 month.
