**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

**TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS – CARVER ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable British Telecom to carry out repair and maintenance works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, subject to the agreement of the London Borough of Southwark, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Carver Road which lies between Herne Hill and No. 157 Carver Road.
2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via (a) Carver Road, Half Moon Lane, Warmington Road, Hollingbourne Road and Herne Hill; and; (b) Herne Hill, Half Moon Lane and Carver Road.
3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order will come into force on 12<sup>th</sup> November 2024 and continue in force for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would take place on 12<sup>th</sup> November 2024 between 9.30 am and 3.30 pm, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 1 month.
