STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ABOVE-MENTIONED ORDERS

The proposals are necessary to improve road safety and to create better conditions for walking cycling and scooting as part of the Council's Road Danger Reduction Programme.

The intended effects of the Road Danger Reduction Programme are to reduce road danger for people to feel comfortable and safe on our streets at all times, thereby encouraging active and sustainable travel. The works will include installing traffic calming measures on Rodenhurst Road and a new raised zebra crossing on Emmanuel Road, near Telferscot Primary School. These measures will reduce the speed of vehicles and in turn, the number of people killed and/or seriously injured on the borough's roads, as speed is often a contributing factor in collisions.
