The Lambeth (Moving Traffic Restrictions) (Amendment No. 04) Experimental Order 2024

Made 13 August 2024

Coming into force 31 August 2024

The Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the

Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(as amended), and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Lambeth (Moving Traffic Restrictions) (Amendment No. 04) Experimental Order 2024 and shall come into force on 26 August 2024.

Interpretation

- 2. (1) In this Order, except where stated, the following expressions shall have the following meanings:-
 - "the Order of 2024" means the Lambeth (Moving Traffic Restrictions) Order 2024(a)
 - "map-based schedule" means the map and legend attached to this Order, which depicts the location of restrictions, prohibitions, and provisions imposed by this Order. The Council does not accept responsibility for any inaccuracies contained in the Ordnance Survey data relied upon to create the map-based schedule and where a prohibition, restriction or provision continues to apply irrespective of any subsequent changes that have been made to the underlying Ordnance Survey data.
 - (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated; re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
 - (3) Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2024 shall have the same meaning as in that Order

Amendment of the Lambeth (Moving Traffic Restrictions) Order 2024

- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, the Order of 2024 is hereby varied: -
 - (a) as identified in the map-based schedule; and,
 - (b) the Schedule of properties eligible for a permit.

Modification or suspension of this Order

4. In pursuance of section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Assistant Director of Infrastructure, Environment, Public Realm & Climate Change Delivery or some other person authorised by them may, if it appears to them essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic, or in the interests of providing suitable and adequate onstreet parking facilities, or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by this Order runs, modify or suspend the operation of this Order or any provision of it, save that no modification shall make an addition.
