## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

## TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - CARLISLE LANE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable bridge inspection works to a railway bridge to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Carlisle Lane which lies:-

(Phase 1) between Westminster Bridge Road and Royal Street (An alternative route for vehicles affected by this closure would be available via Westminster Bridge Road, Lambeth Palace Road and Royal Street); and

(Phase 2) directly beneath the railway bridge between Hercules Road and a point 41 metres north-west of Hercules Road. (An alternative route for vehicles affected by this closure would be available via Lambeth Road, Kennington Road, Westminster Bridge Road, Lambeth Palace Road and Royal Street).

- 2. Whenever the bans referred to in paragraph 1 above apply, the one-way system in Carlisle Lane, between Royal Street and Hercules Road would be temporarily suspended.
- 3. The bans and suspension would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 8<sup>th</sup> January 2025 and would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the order would only have effect (for Phase 1) on the 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> January 2025 between 9 pm and 5 am, and (for Phase 2) on the 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> January 2025 between 9 pm and 5 am, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time, the Order may have effect on subsequent dates within the maximum period of 2 months.
