TEMPORARY PARKING, STOPPING, WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS

LAMBETH HIGH STREET

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable development related works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban any vehicle from waiting (including waiting for the purposes of loading and unloading a vehicle) at any time, in that length of Lambeth High Street (east side) which lies between a point 30 metres south of Old Paradise Street (opposite No. 46 Lambeth High Street), and a point 67 metres north of Whitgift Street.
- 2. The ban on parking, stopping, waiting and loading would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 3. The Order would come into force on 6th January 2025 and would continue for a maximum duration of 6 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would have effect from 6th January 2025 to 6 June 2025 between 9.30 am and 3.30 pm, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order would also have effect at subsequent dates and times within the maximum period of 6 months.
