ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY CYCLE LANE AND FOOTWAY CLOSURE – ROSENDALE ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable BT pole replacement works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order, the effect of which would be to temporarily ban pedestrians and cyclists from entering the footway and cycle lane on Rosendale Road, between the property boundaries of No. 258 and No. 250 Rosendale Road.
2. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
3. Cyclists are required to dismount and use the pedestrian diversion on the adjacent footway of Rosendale Road.
5. The Order would come into force on 13th January 2025 for a maximum duration of 1 month or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that works would be carried out between on 13th January 2025, between the hours of 10.am and 3.30 pm, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during those times, the Order may also have effect on subsequent dates within the maximum period of 1 month.
