TEMPORARY PARKING RESTRICTIONS - CORNWALL ROAD

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable development related works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily:
- (i) ban vehicles from waiting (including waiting for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) in that length of the south-western side of Cornwall Road which lies between Upper Ground and Doon Street;
- (ii) suspend parking in that length of the south-western side of Cornwall Road which lies between Upper Ground and Doon Street.
- 2. The ban on waiting and loading would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 3. The Order would come into effect on 3rd March 2025 and would continue for a maximum duration of 12 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works will be carried out between 3rd March 2025 and 3rd November 2025. If the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time, then the Order may have effect on subsequent dates within the maximum period of 12 months.
