**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

**TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS – JONATHAN STREET**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable new water connection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Jonathan Street which lies between Vauxhall Walk and Worgan Street.
2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via a) Vauxhall Walk, Glasshouse Walk and Tyers Street and (b) Tyers Street, Black Prince Road and Vauxhall Walk.
3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order would come into force on 17<sup>th</sup> February 2025 and continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would take place between 17<sup>th</sup> February 2025 and 25<sup>th</sup> February 2025, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect on subsequent days within the maximum period of 1 month.
