'What do I do next – my child has not received an offer of a school place, but is at a through school?'

General advice

Q1: Why wasn't my child offered a place at any of the schools I noted on my child's Common Application Form (CAF)?

A: For each of these schools there were more applications than places, and the offers they made would have been made according to the school's published admissions criteria, and other children had a higher priority than your child under the school's published admission criteria.

Details about how offers were made for Lambeth schools will be published online via lambeth.gov.uk/eadmissions shortly after 3 March 2025.

If you would like a more specific reason explaining why your child was not offered a place at any school, you should contact the admissions authority that is responsible for allocating places at each school within the next few days.

Q2: Can I request that my child's name remains on the waiting list of any of the schools that I applied to but did not receive an offer from?

A: Yes. Please contact the school's admissions authority for the schools concerned to request this - refer to Tables 1 and 2 for contact information. For Lilian Baylis Technology School, The Norwood School and Woodmansterne School your child's name will automatically be placed on the waiting list if it was a higher preference from the one received.

Please note that that details of waiting list places will not be available immediately, as lists need to be reordered which may take a week or so to include late applications etc.

Please also be aware that waiting lists are maintained in accordance with the school's admissions criteria. Usually these are kept until 31 December 2025 (one term after the start of the new academic year). This is the case for Lambeth community schools. After this time a new In-Year application is required for your child's name to continue on the waiting list.

Q3: Why has Lambeth School Admissions Team not allocated a place for my child at another school with a vacancy?

A: Lambeth School Admissions Team has not made an 'allocated offer' at a school with a vacancy not listed on your CAF that you have not applied for, as your child currently attends a school which has/will have a year 7 intake. So in accordance with *The Education (Pupil Registration) (England) Regulations 2006, Section 8 - Deletions from Admission Register* your child's name will remain on the school's roll in September 2025 unless you secure a place elsewhere and takes that place up instead.

Q4: Can I apply for another school?

A: Yes. However, you need to apply using the Lambeth CAF and complete any Supplementary Information Forms that may be required. Lambeth Schools Admissions Team will be able to inform you of details of any vacancies in Lambeth schools as well as in other boroughs after 24 March 2025 (when all acceptance forms have been logged).

Please note that the availability of vacancies will change, so you are advised to apply for new schools ASAP while the school may still have places available.

Lambeth's School Admissions Team will co-ordinate all second or new CAFs that are submitted until 31 August 2025.

Q5: Can I appeal against the decision to not offer my child a place at any of the schools I applied for?

- **A:** Yes. Under the School Standards and Framework Act 1998, you have the right to appeal against the decision not to admit your child to a school. If you wish to appeal against the decision not to offer your child a place at the following schools:
 - The Elms Academy
 - Lilian Baylis Technology School
 - The Norwood School
 - Woodmansterne School
 - Oasis Academy South Bank

If you wish to appeal against the decision not to admit your child to any other secondary school, you will need to contact the individual school(s) direct, to obtain information about how to appeal.

If your application for a school place was submitted on-time, appeals need to be lodged by **31 March 2025** for them to be heard before the summer holidays. For late applications, an appeal should be lodged within 20 school days of receipt of application outcome letter. Appeals lodged after these dates will be heard within 40 school days of the appeal deadline or 30 school days of being lodged, whichever is the later date.

Glossary of terms

Admissions authority = the body responsible for the admission of children to a school.

Admissions criteria = the rules admissions authorities use to look at applications and to decide which children are given places at a school.

Appeal = This is a formal request to a "higher" body to review the action, procedure, or decision of an admissions authority, which did not offer a child a place at the school. For school appeals, this higher body would be an independent appeals panel). Pursuing an appeal does not guarantee a place will be offered at the school.

Common Application Form (CAF) = This is a pre-formatted paper or online form that parent/carers MUST complete in order to apply for a school place for their child. This online or paper form must be submitted to Lambeth School Admissions Team if this is the child's home Local Authority.

Preference = the school(s) parent/carers list on the CAF that they would like their child to attend. If parent/carers are applying for more than one school then these schools should be listed in the order of your preferred choice, i.e., the school you most want your child to attend as preference 1, your second choice as preference 2, and so on.

Supplementary Information Form = an additional information form that is required by some schools, mainly church schools, If a school requires this form to be completed then parent/carers MUST complete both the Common Application Form and the supplementary form.

Waiting list = the list of children who have applied to a particular school which was not able to make an offer at the time of application, but who are willing to place the child on this "list". Children who reject an offer will have their place filled by children on this list. This list is managed in line with the school's admissions criteria.
