Dear Resident / Business,

The purpose of this leaflet is to inform you about the outcome of the statutory consultation carried out in August/September 2024 regarding the proposal to amend parking arrangements and/or yellow lines in your street, and to inform you of the Council's decision.

Council Decision

All public representations received, along with officers' recommendations, were presented in a report considered by the Council. After careful consideration, a decision has been made to proceed with the introduction of the proposed measures.

What Happens Next?

The final Traffic Management Orders (TMOs), which allow the restrictions to be implemented and administered, will be finalised shortly, and a notice outlining this will be published in the London Gazette and the local newspaper (South London Weekly). The Council's contractors will make arrangements to introduce the measures, with works commencing the week starting 31st March.

Whilst work is being undertaken in your street, please avoid parking where any of the proposed measures are to be introduced and where "No Parking" cones have been put in place. This will allow time for works to proceed efficiently and for the works to be carried out as quickly as possible.

Temporary parking restrictions may be introduced to prevent vehicles from obstructing the work. Offending vehicles run the risk of receiving a fine and possible relocation.

The Council is conscious of the inconvenience and disruption that this work may cause and will endeavour to keep the impact to a minimum. We apologise in advance for any inconvenience that may be caused whilst the works are being carried out.
