## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

## TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - BRIXTON STATION ROAD

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Sustainable Drainage Buildout (SuDs) works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Brixton Station Road which lies between Brixton Road and Pope's Road.
- 2. An alternative route for vehicles would be available via Brixton Station Road, Gresham Road and Brixton Road.
- 3. The restrictions would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The order would come into force on 14<sup>th</sup> March 2025 and would continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies). In practice it is anticipated that the order would only have effect on 14<sup>th</sup> March 2025 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect on subsequent days within the maximum duration of 18 months.
