ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS LILFORD ROAD

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable carriageway and footway works to be carried out in Lilford Road, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban:-
 - (a) pedestrians from entering that length of the northern footway of Lilford Road which lies between a point opposite No. 74 Lilford Road and a point 37 metres west of Carew Street (alternative routes for pedestrians would be available on the opposite footway, the south side of Lilford Road);
 - (b) vehicles entering that length of the Lilford road which lies between No. 100 Lilford Road and Paulett Road (alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Coldharbour Lane and Loughborough Road and vice versa);
 - (c) waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading a vehicle) in that length of Lilford Road, both sides, which lies between No. 100 Lilford Road and Paulett Road.
- 2. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 3. The Order would come into force on 31st March 2025 and would continue for a maximum duration of 6 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner.
