ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - KINGSMEAD ROAD

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable new gas connection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Kingsmead Road which lies between Palace Road and a point 50 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Kingsmead Road.
- 2. Alternative routes for vehicles would be available via Palace Road, Northstead Road, Kingsmead Road and vice versa.
- 3. The restrictions would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs. Access for residents would be maintained.
- 4. The order would come into force on 7th April 2025 and would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the order would only have effect between 7th April 2025 and 11th April 2025 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect on subsequent days within the maximum duration of 2 months.
