ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS – ST JULIAN’S FARM ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable telecommunications repair and maintenance works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intends to make an Order, the effect of which would be to temporarily prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding, waiting, including waiting for the purpose of loading and unloading a vehicle or parking in that length of St Julian’s Farm Road which lies between outside the common boundary of Nos. 15 and 17 St Julian’s Farm Road, and its junction with Casewick Road.
2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Casewick Road, Thornlaw Road and Knights Hill, or via Knights Hill, Wolfington Road and Casewick Road.
3. The Order would come into force on 30 March 2026 and continue in force for a maximum duration of one month, or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works will take 2 days to complete.
