ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

**TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS – SOMERLEYTON ROAD AND
LOUGHBOROUGH PARK**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to provide an access and egress lane for works vehicles associated with a nearby building development, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intends to make an Order, the effect of which would be to:
 - (a) temporarily prohibit vehicles from parking or waiting, including waiting for the purpose of loading and unloading in Somerleyton Road, north-east side, between outside the common boundary of Nos. 117 and 119 Somerleyton Road, and outside the north-western flank wall of Nos. 256 to 284 Loughborough Park;
 - (b) temporarily convert the resident permit parking place on Loughborough Road outside Nos. 256 to 284 Loughborough Park to a disabled persons parking place, operative at all times, for use by vehicles displaying a valid disabled badge.
2. The Order would come into force on 20 April 2026 and would continue in force for a maximum duration of 18 months.
